

Series Theme Verse

*¹⁶For I am **not ashamed of the Gospel**, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. ¹⁷For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, “The righteous shall live by faith.”*

Romans 1:16-17 ESV

In the Gospel, God reveals His righteousness in the justification of sinners by grace, through faith, in Christ.

1. We are justified through faith alone.

²¹But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— ²²the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe.

Romans 3:21-22a ESV

2. We are justified by God’s grace alone.

²²For there is no distinction: ²³for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus...

Romans 3:22b-24 ESV

3. We are justified in Christ alone.

...²⁵whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. ²⁶It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
